As there is not a lot of news to report, I am going to do a section of our rules and regulations. Knowing that a lot of you have friends and family visiting, I am reviewing:

**Rule XIV, Guests, Relatives & Children**

1. All overnight guests must register at the office and display a vehicle guest pass. Guests are permitted to stay up to a maximum of (21) days/nights in the park that must be followed by thirty (30) consecutive days/nights out of the park. Guests must be registered at the office and display their vehicle identifying tag. Guests not staying in the park shall limit use of recreational facilities to a maximum of four (4) days per month.
2. Friends, relatives and children will be permitted to occupy the unit owner's home for up to twenty-one (21) days/nights during the absence of the unit owner with written approval of the unit owner. The owner is responsible for notifying the office when this situation occurs.
3. Roomers or boarders are not considered guests and are not permitted.
4. Only registered guests are permitted to use the recreational facilities. Tenants and unit owners are responsible for the safety and conduct of their guests. Visiting children under the age of eighteen (18) must be accompanied by a responsible adult when using the facilities of the park. The ultimate responsibility lies with the owner. Animal pets of guests will not be permitted anywhere on the premises overnight.
5. Power cart drivers must be sixteen (16) years of age.
