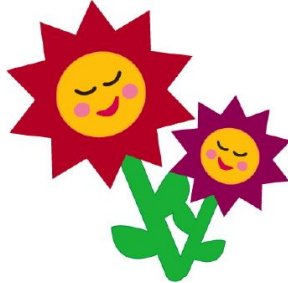
SUZY SUMMAN
