discussion, motion to upgrade geothermal units at cost of \$7700 was approved.

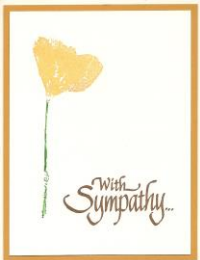
Three units approved for transfer
